If there is lots of rain or it is very hot, the show will be inside. Then you will be sitting either on the floor or in rows of seats.

They are wearing costumes. Costumes help us believe the actors and to help tell the story.



This is Pip, Lucy and Tristan.

Tristan is holding Squeaker. Squeaker is a big rat puppet. She is very soft and she is the heroine of the show.

In the show, Tristan's character, Boy, signs up to work for Lucy's character Mr Skudlies.

Mr Skudlies runs a rubbish dump and is lying about what happens to the rubbish there.

Boy and Squeaker become friends and together they defeat Mr Skudlies.

In the show there is lots of music and some loud noises. There is also some stage fighting. No one is hurt in the fighting – it is all rehearsed and choreographed.
